# Playground Guidelines

# **General Playground Rules**

- 1. Follow all adult directions.
- 2. No food leaves the lunchroom.
- 3. No climbing fences or going into parking lots or the road to retrieve a ball.
- 4. No bringing your own equipment out to **lunch recess**.

# Winter rules

- 1. Make sure kids wear coats in cold weather.
- 2. No throwing snow or ice.
- No sliding on ice or snow. Snow hill must be supervised with no King of the Hill games or building tunnels.

#### Slide Area

- 1. No jumping off playground equipment.
- 2. No balls, jump ropes, or chase games in the slide area. These can be played on the grass or blacktop.
- 3. No standing on ANY bars.
- 4. No climbing on top of the slide area or up the slides.
- 5. No throwing wood chips.
- 6. No climbing out of the slide and sliding down the pole or jumping off of the slide.
- 7. Do not push snow or wood chips down the slide.

#### **Grass Area**

- Football, soccer, baseball, etc. should be played here and not on the blacktop.
- 2. No tackling.
- 3. No lifting/carrying friends around.
- 4. Do not touch or sit on gates by the parking lots.
- 5. Tag can be played when a lunch supervisor or teacher is watching.

### **Blacktop Area**

 Use this area for basketball, jump rope, hopscotch, four-square, and other blacktop games.

# **Playground Supervisors:**

- Please be noticeable!
- Walking around creates visibility.
- Fewer problems will occur if students are aware you are there to monitor their behavior.
- Make conversation with students to build a positive relationship.
- Be respectful of students by using kind, positive words even when resolving conflict.
- One of the best ways to prevent problems is being aware of them.
- Move closer and stop any inappropriate actions. Remember, this is a safe place for children to learn how to become better people.
